STANDING ORDER 2017-JO-IV-01

This Standing Order shall be in effect on July 1, 2017 until such time as it is rescinded or modified. This Standing Order rescinds and modifies in part Standing Orders 2015-JO-IV-02 and 2015-JO-IV-04.

JUVENILE DOCKET

Cases under Chapter 211 of the Revised Statutes of the State of Missouri pending in Division IV of the Circuit Court of Johnson County, Missouri shall be heard on the following dates:

July 11, 2017	October 24, 2017
August 8, 2017	November 13, 2017
September 12, 2017	December 12, 2017

The morning docket shall start at 8:30 a.m. and the afternoon docket shall start at 1:30 p.m. Depending on scheduling an afternoon docket may not be held on each of the above dates. The scheduling of cases shall be by the Court in accordance with the time standards established by Missouri Supreme Court Rules of Practice and Procedure in Juvenile and Family Court Divisions of the Family Court.

Any case not scheduled for a particular docket by the Court may be placed on a particular docket by contacting the Court to determine the appropriate time to schedule the hearing. It shall be the responsibility of the requesting party to provide a notice of hearing in accordance with Rule 44.01 to all parties, including any unrepresented parties, the Children's Division of the Missouri Department of Social Services or its contracted case management agency. It shall not be the responsibility of the filing party to provide notice to any placement provider, which shall remain the responsibility of the Children's Division of the Missouri Department of Social Services or its contracted case management agency.

CIVIL LAW DAYS

In accordance with Rule 2.3 of the Circuit Court of the Seventeenth Judicial Circuit, Division IV establishes civil law days to be held on the following dates:

July 17, 2017	October 16, 2017
August 7, 2017	October 23, 2017
August 21, 2017	November 6, 2017
September 11, 2017	November 20, 2017
September 18, 2017	December 4, 2017
	December 18, 2017

Such law days shall start at 1:30 p.m. In addition to the matters permitted to be heard on law days under Rule 2.4 of the Circuit Court of the Seventeenth Judicial Circuit, motions for mediation, trial setting and scheduling orders may also be noticed for hearing on law days. Motions and hearings that will require evidence or take longer than five (5) minutes may be scheduled for a later date.

CRIMINAL LAW DAYS

In accordance with Rule 2.3 of the Circuit Court of the Seventeenth Judicial Circuit, Division IV establishes criminal law days to be held on the following dates:

December 6, 2017	


Such law days shall start at 9:00 a.m. Motions and hearings that will require evidence or take longer than five (5) minutes may be scheduled for a later date.
